North Carolina Museum of Arts Demo—CANCELLED!

The museum added an outdoor public event which altered the set up time of our original plan. The nature of the new event also limited our set up to the morning before the event. This significantly reduce the number of individuals available to set up that day, availability of pavilions are rendered it impossible to reasonably accomplish. We were also concerned about security once the pavilions were erected. The new museum event opened up the potential for unauthorized access by the public to the pavilions in the afternoon and evening after setup; pavilions are a huge investment and repairs or replacement could be financially horrific and emotionally devastating. We hope an invitation will be extended in the future and we will examine the situation anew and hope that all understand the reasons we have decided not to participate this year.
