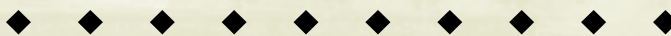

Demo Activities: Armored fighting, Rapier Fighting, A&S Display. A fighting area will be available all day. The Chatelaines will host an area for guests to put on garb and take pictures.

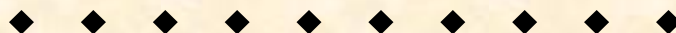

Pennsic Life

"You're doing medieval camping for two weeks in the middle of the summer? Are you crazy?" This is what I hear just about every year from family, friends (in and out of the SCA), and co-workers. What do I tell them? Well, that it's not as crazy as it sounds. In fact for me it's the perfect vacation, I couldn't imagine anything better. I have been going to Pennsic for four years now though this was just the second year I was actually in the SCA and I have to say SCAdians know how to camp.

First and foremost you have the camp site itself. Cooper's Lake is a great site and large enough to fit 11,600ish people. It's amazing as you wander around at how many people and groups that come to enjoy all that Pennsic offers. Some groups go completely period, some completely modern, and a lot that appear period but have all the benefits of modern camping. I don't know about you but I love having a shower in my camp, not to mention a stove to cook on and a cooler to keep items cold. Next there is my "tent". When I tell my family I sleep in a tent they assume your everyday modern tent that isn't large enough for you to stand up in. While this wouldn't be so bad, I would much rather have the 12x12 regent tent that I am lucky to be able to borrow from friends. Inside my tent is a nice comfy queen size bed (air mattresses are better now than they used to be) and I still have room left over for a sitting area and all my armor.

"What do you do for two weeks?" they ask. Well, the first week (which we call peace week since there are no battles) is when I tend to take various classes. Pennsic University does a wonderful job lining up tons of classes of anything you can think of, from fiber arts to cooking to history of fighting and much more. In the second week I throw on my armor and go fight in the melees, which takes up most my morning and can bleed into my afternoon. After that it's more classes or find a good spot to read or work on some project. Watching the fighting is almost as fun as participating. Where else in the world can you find 2-3 thousand men and women going to battle against each other in face to face combat and then helping each other up when the battle is over? At the end of the day I may be found at Kingdom or Baronial court or sitting around the common tent chatting away with friends or even out and about enjoying a party hosted by a friend.



"Isn't it too hot for camping?" is a question I get a lot. You know, those people living in the SCA time frame knew a thing or two about what clothes to wear when it's hot (or cold, for that matter). Linen and even cotton pull the sweat off you and dry fast which helps keep you cool. Though it still gets rather hot - but an ice cold foot bath does much to help cool you off and soothe sore feet. Not to mention the cabana boys... oh wait, that's my wishful thinking. A lot of times hanging around camp in the shade catching the breeze does much to help keep you cool, but you can also volunteer at troll and bask in the breeze created by the fans while you meet lots of new people and help them get their Pennsic experience started.

I think one of the greatest parts for me is that for two weeks I can disconnect from the modern world and reconnect with the simpler things in life that often get pushed aside by the TV, internet, and other such things. Does that mean I don't have my phone?... of course not. I need to be reachable in case something happens in the real world. But I can set aside everything else and enjoy my vacation. Yes, I must say SCAdians know how to camp and Pennsic is a great chance to relax and have fun playing the game.
