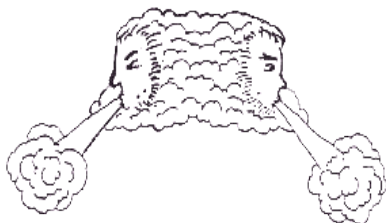

Order of the Boreas

For Excellence in Arts & Sciences

Blazon:

(Fieldless) Two boreae addorsed and conjoined argent

Heraldic Definitions:

Fieldless = A design which may be presented on any background, for example, a maker's mark.

Addorsed = A pair of charges facing away from each other

Conjoined = Joined together, so as to touch each other

Argent = White/silver

Registered October 1979
Name Re-Registered April 1982
