Given for single noteworthy act of service

Blazon:
(Fieldless) an annulet Vert platy

Heraldic Definitions:
Fieldless = A design which may be presented on any background, for example, a maker's mark.
Annulet = a ring
Vert = green
Platy = A semy of Plates.
(Semy is strewed over with figures & plate is a white roundel)

Chancery January Meeting Notes

Greetings from Baroness Michel Almond de Champagn, OL, OP (blah blah blah)

A few members of WMH attended the first Chancery meeting on Sunday, January 14th.

Agenda:

Members filled out the WMH Chancery Membership Form.

1. Discussion of what the Chancery is

The Chancery (chancellerie) is the "Writing office of archives for records" for the Barony. The goal of a "Chancery" meeting is to provide a space for people who are interested in the scribal arts to gather, learn, and share knowledge related to the business of award creation for the Barony as well as an opportunity to learn about various arts within the SCA. The Chancery is not a guild and does not use a merit based system for members, nor is member determined by the Officers, rather the Chancery is open to all artist that live in the barony who wish to support the award process.

2. Officers of the Chancery

Michel (Michel Almond de Champagne) has been appointed as Mistress of the Chancery (MotC). Her duties include: Setting the agenda for monthly meetings, working with the Baronage and scribes on assignments, maintaining accurate records in the Big Red Book, keeping the Deputy of the Chancery and the Baronial Herald up to date on assignments, Promoting the Award creation arts, Cheerleader.

Michele Stech (Philomene de Lys) has been appointed as Deputy of the Chancery (DotC). Her duties include learning the duties of the MotC and working with the members of the Chancery. She is also in charge of the Inter-baronial Gatherings.

3. Selection of the Officers

When the MotC steps down, the DotC will step up and will appoint a new Deputy in his/her place. Approval from the Baronage is needed.

4. Term Limit of the officers

The office will be held for one calendar year only and the MotC cannot hold the office for 2 consecutive years. There must be a turnover. ie the MotC cannot be the deputy to her/his deputy.

5. FB group

The goal of the FB group is to keep all members informed of deadlines and to promote the Chancery. It is not to be used to give out assignments or discussing assignments. The name of the group is "Chancery - Calligraphers & Illuminators Guild of Windmasters' Hill". Please contact Michel if you would like to be added.

6. 2018 Calendar

Each year the Chancery office will publish a calendar of meetings. It is recommended that the members be allowed to meet in a social setting once a month whereby the officers can update the members on the Assignment process as well as promoting the arts. The current schedule is as follows: Each meeting will be held on the 2nd Sunday of the Month. **The February meeting will be at Tankreds home. The March meeting will be at Michels home and the April meeting will be at Philomene's home. More dates are under construction.**

7. Quarterly excursion

It is recommended that the Chancery office promote quarterly excursions that will be of interests to the members. This is an opportunity for the members to learn more about the arts and to socialize. Ideas include: Museums, Art Stores, Inter-Baronial Workshop, University. It was recommended that the first excursion be to the NC Art Museum. Philomene and Michel are looking into this and will post information soon.

Chancery January Meeting Notes (Cont.)

8. Membership

Membership is open to all persons who are members of the WMH Barony and are interested in promoting the ARTS and the WMH Award system. This includes scribal arts, embroidery, woodworking, metalsmiths, bards, etc. It is important that the group not be limited to the Scribal arts.

9. Inter-baronial Gatherings

The DotC will be in charge of promoting the WMH Chancery with other baronies. The goal is to set up opportunities for members to attend workshops and to share resources.

10. Assignment Policy and the Big Red Book

The MotC will work with the Baron and Baroness to obtain the list of assignments in a timely fashion. All pertinent details will be obtained and recorded in the Big Red Book (BRB) and then given to scribes as "Assignments".

The MotC will contact a scribe to see if he/she would like the assignment. The pertinent details will be communicated to the scribe along with the scroll number. This number should be written on the back of the completed scroll by the scribe and given to the Herald in charge of the court or to an officer of the Chancery at the appropriate event.

If the scribe is unable to meet the deadline, it is requested that the MotC be notified as soon as possible so the BRB can be updated and the Baronage/Event Herald notified. It is assumed the scribe will complete the scroll assignment by the next event. If not, the assignment will be given to another scribe. At no point should an assignment remain on the BRB for more than 2 events. It is a priority of the Chancery to make sure that all promissory notes are acted on and that all award scrolls are processed in a timely fashion.

After the event, the Chancery would like each scribe to post a picture of the scroll on FB. Not only will this complete the assignment process, but it is a great way to help other scribes be inspired.

11. Numbering

The MotC has developed a numbering system that will be used when communicating information about assignments. This system is used to maintain confidentiality as well as accurate record keeping. The system is as follows.

Example:

DT17001 (Daemon Typhaine) (year) (scroll number)

Backlog scrolls prior to 2018 will not have a number

12. Assignments were discussed. If anyone is interested in an assignment for YMIR, please contact Michel asap.
